We started with about 55 people and ended with 43 people. It was given by a psychologist who works at Caritas Linares. A very good course, where we could become aware of our own reality, our wounds, our personal weaknesses; it is a time to get to know ourselves and experience healing. Personally, I have realized that I have wounds that have already healed enough and I have felt that from there I can serve better.

This course ended on Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 April 2019 with the awarding of a diploma and fraternal sharing. The possibility of a new project, more focused on putting what we had learned into practice, was considered.

Although this course gave our experience its full place, we all felt the need to deepen our practice. I am very happy to have taken this training.
