Return of pupils to the Providence Amparibe School

After a long period of total lockdown, Providence Amparibe school solemnly opened for the 2020-2021 school year, with students and teachers and the Sisters in charge of the school gathered in the Assembly Yard for general guidelines.



Despite strict respect for social distancing required by Covid 19 regulations, the students were happy to meet again and their parents were happy that classes could resume. A Mass was celebrated to mark the start of the new year.

First confession of 68 students from Providence School ,

On Saturday, November 21, 2020, 68 students from Providence School received the Sacrament of Confession for the first time



The celebration opened at 8am with a short introduction from Sr. Bernadette Lucienne, Headteacher. Four priests administered the Sacrament. Sr Dolline, who prepared the students, accompanied the celebration with an animation: reading the Word of God, songs, meditation, music, all punctuated by times of silence.



Each child was accompanied by one of his/her parents as they went towards the Priest, and then when they had received the Sacrament, the other parent welcomed the student and accompanied him/her to their place.

After the students, the parents received the Sacrament of Confession. In this way the parents give a good example to their children. The celebration closed with Mass and photo sessions.

About 30 students from 4th grade will have a time of recollection next week before their Solemn Communion which will be celebrated on Sunday, November 29, 2020.
