In our Community Apostolic Project (CAP), every second and third Sunday of the month, we have decided to devote one hour together to the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We are united with the "People of God who are on pilgriming in Chile" and who are celebrating the "National Eucharistic Congress 2018"; we also entrust to the Lord all that we have experienced during the process of structural change in our Congregation and the crisis we are experiencing in the Chilean Church. Every first Friday of the month, we devote enough time to share the Word of God, it is Lectio Divina:

4- We act: To what does God invite me daily; what does He offers me through His Word?

It is a rich exercise to listen to each other, to understand and live the Word of God, to enrich ourselves.

In the Parish of Longaví, training courses for pastoral workers are held every first Saturday of the month in different areas. Counsellors provide this training. Sister Violette is one of the counsellors. The theme of the meetings is "The Eucharist, joy of the encounter with Christ" which is the first theme of the 2018 National Eucharistic Congress.
