On 27th December 1976, in the presence of Cardinal Marty, Archbishop of Paris, Father Dortel-Claudot, delegated by Rome, solemnly proclaimed the birth in the Church of the Congregation of the Sisters of Christ, Union Musterium Christi »: just as tributaries meet to form one unique and new river so the past Congregations have disappeared and now form one new and unique Congregation.

« You have not foreseen everything, but be joyful because you have Hope »








As Abraham set off not knowing where he was going, so we followed the path, empowered by the Spirit
